Mon 3rd Loving God, We praise you for your coming to us in Christ, walking your earth and sharing our humanity. We praise you for the inspiration you give us through Jesus.

Tues 4th We remember how you reached out through the ministry of Christ, welcoming whom society had rejected, accepting those whom the world considered unacceptable, for you accept us, just as we are.

Wed 5th On this first day of Lent, we remember Jesus going alone into the wilderness to commune with his heavenly father and was tempted by Satan. How often do we go to a quiet space to talk to our Lord and have to resist the temptations Satan throws at us. Lord, accept our prayers, our praise and our love.

Thurs 6th Lord, you have taught us that we should long to know you better, not just want that, we should yearn for that, urgently and passionately and strive to understand your will and fulfil your purpose so that we do not cluttering our lives with so much clutter we do not have space for you.
